

Minutes from Tamalpa Board Meeting  
July 6, 2015

Dave Ripp gave a report on the 2015 MMDR race. Overall participation was good this year. About 50 more runners in the 10K over last year slightly less on the 5K. This was partly due to using Jason Jacobsons database of more that 16,000 area runners. Overall expenses were in line we netted approximately \$8500 donated \$1,000 to San Quentin running program and \$1,000 to Pancreatic cancer research. Only complaint was not enough small shirts. Bruce Linscott gave a recap of the Tamalpa sponsored Rucky Chucky aid station at this years WS100. We had a good group of volunteers 35-40 people total. Hot day approximately 100 runners dropped before reaching our aid station. Bruce pledged to continue to run aid station and asked that Tamalpa budget something to support his efforts. \$1,000 was mentioned as appropriate.
