

Tamalpa May Track Meet, May 19, 2022

The first Summer Tamalpa Track Meet of 2022 was originally scheduled to be held on May 17, 2022, but a conflict with a San Rafael High School function on May 17, 2022 required the Track Meet to be moved to Thursday, May 19, 2022. As a result, the attendance at the Track Meet was lower than expected, as we had 30 separate Runners run events in the Track Meet.

The first race of the meet was the One Mile Race. 13-year-old Lucas Ruark took the lead from the start and was able to hold off a hard charging 14-year-old Jack Turner on the final lap to win the race with an excellent 4:58.42 to Jack's 4:59.89 second place finish. 10-year-old Louisa Bartlett was the first female finisher with a fine time of 6:14.63. 65-Year-Old Tom O'Reilly had the highest age grade score for the race as he finished with a 5:44.93 for an age grade of 83.9%.

The next race was the 400M and Lucas Ruark won his second Race of the Meet with a fine 1:03:91. 12-year-old Reese Patton was the first female finisher with a 1:12.65 and had the highest the highest age graded performance in the Race with a 76.10%

The 800M race was next and Jack Turner was the winner as he was able to beat second place Lucas Ruark with his 2:23.70 to Lucas' 2:27.80. Taking third place was the first female finisher 17-year-old Alexa Polsky with a fast 2:31.46. 67-year-old 63-year-old Christian Oakes had the highest age grade in the race with his 2:38:48 finish and an age grade score of 81.52%.

The next race was the 200M and 53-year-old Maximo Garcia won easily with a time of 0:25.60. Maximo also had the highest age grade with a 89.38%. We had no female finishers in the 200M.

Maximo was a repeat winner with his first-place finish in the 100M race with a very fast 0:12.18. His age grade for the race was 91.87%, which was also the highest age grade in the Track Meet. 12-year-old Reese Patton was the first female finisher with a time of 0:15:11.

The final two races of the meet, the 2 Mile and the 5000M, were run concurrently to close the meet. Lucas Ruark won his 3rd Race in the Meet with a time of 11:44.88. Second Place finisher was Liz Gottlieb with a time of 13:09.26 and had the highest age graded performance of 76.40% for the race.

Sean Coffin was the winner in the 5000M with a time of 17:31.55. Carolyn Latham was the first female finisher in 19:21.56 and had the highest age grade in the race with a 77.44%.

Jason Reed and Joseph Makonnen were the ironman for the track meet, as they ran in the maximum of 6 races in the Meet.

Thanks to Kevin Rumon, Christian Oakes, Tom Lyons, Mark Churchill and Liz Gottlieb for doing the timing and race results for the meet, Reese Laughlin and Lillie O'Reilly for registering runners and Liz Gottlieb for acting as the starter for the sprints. The next Tamalpa Track meet will be on Tuesday, June 14, 2022, at 6:30 PM at the San Rafael High School Track.
